However, depending on your membership level, coupons **may not guarantee placement** if the trip is oversubscribed by coupon holders.

If a trip is oversubscribed, a drawing will be held to determine the final trip list. You will be notified of your application's status shortly after the trip's deadline date. If a trip has available space after the deadline date passes, applications may be accepted. Please call your trip's coordinator for more information.
