

THE EVENT

Museums by Moonlight is an elegant black tie gala benefiting two extraordinary art museums: the Cantor Arts Center and the Anderson Collection at Stanford University. Held only once every two years, this much anticipated event begins with cocktails under the stars followed by a sumptuous dinner and dancing in the Rodin Sculpture Garden. Guests have exclusive access to the galleries throughout the evening—and in 2022, there will be a special preview of a major new exhibition opening as part of the Cantor’s Asian American Art Initiative.

THE IMPACT

Support from this gala directly benefits the extraordinary depth and breadth of visual arts programs serving the Stanford campus, greater Bay Area community, and beyond. The impact of these programs extends to K-12 schools in three counties; Stanford students, staff, and faculty; and members of the general public from across the nation and around the globe.

Specifically, support from *Museums by Moonlight* makes the following possible—and so much more:

- Free admission for all visitors year-round
- Free school programs and tours for area K-12 students
- Free docent tours, talks in the galleries, and art-making activities
- Free digital programs to complement on-site visits
- Free exhibition publications to extend the museum experience

CANTOR ARTS CENTER AT STANFORD UNIVERSITY

Founded when the university opened in 1891, the museum was expanded and renamed in 1999 for lead donors Iris and B. Gerald Cantor. The Cantor’s collection spans 5,000 years and more than 38,000 works of art, including the largest collection of sculptures by renowned master Auguste Rodin in an American museum. With 24 galleries, special exhibitions each year, and free admission, the Cantor is one of the most visited university art museums in the country, attracting visitors from Stanford’s academic community, the San Francisco Bay Area, and from around the world.

ANDERSON COLLECTION AT STANFORD UNIVERSITY

The Anderson Collection at Stanford University is an extraordinary collection of modern and contemporary American paintings and sculpture. The museum was established by a generous gift of 121 works from the private collection of Harry W. and Mary Margaret Anderson and Mary Patricia Anderson Pence, from one of the world’s most outstanding private assemblies of art built by the family over the past 50 years. The collection has expanded with gifts of paintings, sculptures, and works on paper. Highlights include examples of the New York School, Bay Area Figuration, Color Field Painting and California Light & Space. The building was designed by Richard Olcott/Ennead Architects and opened in 2014.
